RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Glens Falls City School District in the County of Warren is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$43,050,269 and to levy the necessary tax, therefore, for the school year July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.

Proposition 1
Lease of School Buses

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Glens Falls City School District is hereby authorized to enter into five year leases for two (2) 66 passenger school buses, two (2) 28 passenger vans and one (1) 21 passenger wheelchair van at a total amount of lease payments not to exceed \$70,000 per year and that the total lease payments for the five year leases would be at an amount not to exceed \$350,000, and such annual lease payments shall be paid out of the operating budget of the District in each of the five years.

Proposition 2
Capital Project

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Glens Falls City School District, Warren County, New York, is hereby authorized to engage in reconstruction and alterations to the School Districts High School Building, Middle School Building, Kensington Road Elementary School Building, Jackson Heights Elementary School Building, Sanford Street Elementary School Building, Big Cross Elementary School Building, Bus Garage, and the Administration Building, and to acquire original furnishings, equipment or apparatus required for the purpose for which the School District buildings are intended to be used in said School District at a total cost not to exceed \$17,550,000 and that the sum of \$17,550,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.

Proposition 3
Lighting for the Athletic Field

RESOLVED, that if Proposition #2 above is approved by the qualified voters of the School District, the Board of Education of the Glens Falls City School District, Warren County, New York is hereby authorized to construct lighting additions to the athletic field adjacent to the High School, and related site work, and to acquire original equipment or apparatus required for the purpose for which the site is intended to be used in said School District at a total cost not to exceed \$691,200 and that the sum of \$691,200 or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.
