Broadway Classroom

This session is taught by Broadway performers from the show the group is seeing. Sheet music will be provided to the group, who will then work with a cast member and a pianist. The workshop recreates a true Broadway rehearsal with the students learning the choreography, staging, and music directly from the Broadway production they are seeing.

About the Show:

Come From Away is a true story from the immediate aftermath of the 9/11 attacks, when 38 international flights (carrying roughly 7,000 people) were forced to land in Gander, Newfoundland (population roughly 9,000). The generosity and hospitality of the locals, who housed and fed the stranded passengers for days, made the news: a small reassurance of human decency in a world smeared with ash.

At the 71st Tony Awards, it was nominated for seven awards including Best Musical, Best Score, Best Book of a Musical and Best Featured Actress in a Musical for Jenn Colella, ultimately winning for Best Direction of a Musical.

RESOLUTION DATED JANUARY 8, 2018

**GLENS FALLS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD OF EDUCATION
REGARDING ADVOCACY PRIORITIES FOR THE 2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

WHEREAS, the Glens Falls City School District strives to provide an outstanding education and post-secondary pathway for each and every student; and

WHEREAS, the District works diligently to meet the needs of all students while still fulfilling the ever increasing list of state mandates and contractual obligations; and

WHEREAS, our School District's free and reduced lunch rate has increased from 34% to 45% since 2011; and

WHEREAS, the district continues to work diligently to create a balanced budget that respects the needs of area taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, property tax levy legislation at the state level has provided an increased need for State Aid to maintain quality programs; and

WHEREAS, public schools are being asked to do more for students than ever before, so they are prepared for college, military or a career; and

WHEREAS, each child in the Glens Falls City School District only has one opportunity to go through the full elementary and secondary educational experience;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Glens Falls City School District Board of Education calls on the New York State Legislature and Governor Andrew Cuomo to act upon the following priorities:

- 1. Fund and Adjust the Foundation Formula**
 - Review and Update the Foundation Amount - currently \$6,340.00 per pupil.
 - Reduce the Income Wealth Index.
 - Adjust the weighting factor for Free and Reduced Lunch to reflect the accurate measure of student need.
 - Maintain the "SAVE Harmless" provision.
 - Provide a minimum increase in foundation aid to all school districts.
- 2. Increase the \$30,000 Threshold on BOCES Aid for Career and Technical Education (CTE) Programs by providing 100% aid ability for the salaries of CTE teachers.**
- 3. Small Group Health Insurance**
 - Create a "carve out" provision in statute to allow all school districts with 51-100 or more employees to continue to participate in an Experienced Rated Health Insurance Consortium or Trust.
- 4. Building Aid for Small Capital Projects:**
 - Increase the threshold for base year capital outlay expenses from the current amount, established in 2002 from \$100,000 to \$250,000 to assist districts in making critical capital improvements.
